

VERIFIED NOTICE OF EXEMPTION Pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 1150.31

Savage Bingham & Garfield Railroad Company ("SBGR"), a non-carrier, files this Notice of Exemption pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 10901 and 49 C.F.R. Part 1150, Subpart D – Exempt Transactions, to permit SBGR to acquire from Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP"), and to operate freight easements upon, over and across: (a) the lines of railroad between Milepost 4.66 at Welby and Milepost 17.10 at Magna ("Garfield Branch"), and between Milepost 0.00 at Kearns and Milepost 2.01 at Bacchus ("Bacchus Branch"); (b) the line of railroad between MP 0.18 and MP 6.60 on UP's Bingham Industrial Lead; and (c) various wye, yard and team tracks on the Bingham Industrial Lead in the vicinity of Midvale; and all in Salt Lake County, Utah.

In support of this Notice of Exemption, SBGR submits the following information as required by 49 C.F.R. § 1150.33:

3) Statement of Agreements

SBGR and UP will shortly enter into a freight operating agreement and related agreements governing SBGR's operations over the Bacchus, and Garfield branches. In addition, as a result of a transaction between the Utah Transit Authority ("UTA") and UP, in which UP will convey the right-of-way its Bingham Industrial Lead to UTA, UP will reserve the rail freight easement over that line, and will convey it to SBGR. SBGR will enter into an Administration and Coordination Agreement with UTA governing the provision of freight rail services over the Bingham Industrial Lead during time separated periods when the planned UTA light rail services are not in operation.

4) Operator of the Property

SBGR will become the operator of the property.

5) Summary of Proposed Transaction

SBGR and UP will execute a freight operating agreement pursuant to which UP will quitclaim to SBGR a rail freight easement over and across (a) the Garfield and Bacchus Branches, and (b) various wye, yard and team tracks on UP's Bingham Industrial Lead in the vicinity of Midvale; all in Salt Lake County, Utah. In addition, UP will quitclaim a rail freight easement to SBGR over UP's Bingham Industrial Lead between MP 0.18 and MP 6.60 in Salt Lake County, Utah. Operations over the Bingham Industrial Lead will be governed by the Administration and Coordination Agreement between SBGR and UTA. Pursuant to this

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agreement, UTA will agree to maintain the Bingham Industrial Lead as well as the Garfield and Bacchus branches. UP and SBGR will interchange traffic at UP's Roper, Utah rail yard.

- The involved transaction is expected to become effective on the later of May 1, 2007 or the effective date of this notice.
- The mileposts of subject property are between Milepost 4.66 at Welby, and Milepost 17.10 at Magna on UP's Garfield Branch; between Milepost 0.00 at Kearns and Milepost 2.01 at Bacchus on UP's Bacchus Branch, and between MP 0.18 and MP 6.60 on UP's Bingham Industrial Lead, a total of 20.87 route miles over which SBGR will acquire freight easements.
- 6) Maps of the Subject Lines are Attached as Exhibit A
- 7) Certification Concerning Projected Revenues

SBGR hereby certifies that its projected revenues as a result of this transaction will not result in SBGR becoming a Class II or Class I rail carrier. SBGR further certifies that the projected annual revenue of SBGR will not exceed \$5 million. Accordingly, the requirements of 49 C.F.R. § 1150.32(e) do not apply to this transaction.

8) A caption summary, as required by 49 C.F.R. § 1150.34 is attached as Exhibit B.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

SBGR's acquisition will not result in significant changes in carrier operations. There will not be a diversion of: (1) more than 1,000 rail carloads a year to motor carriage; or (2) an average of 50 carloads per mile per year for any part of this line to motor carriage. Moreover, this transaction will not result in: (1) an increase in rail traffic of at least 100 percent or an increase of

at least eight trains a day on any segment of the line; (2) an increase of rail yard activity of at

least 100 percent; or (3) an average increase in truck traffic of more than 10 percent of the

average daily or 50 vehicles a day. SBGR's acquisition and operating rights will not affect a

Class I or nonattainment area under the Clean Air Act. In any event, the thresholds of 49 C.F.R.

§ 1105.7(e)(5)(ii) will not be exceeded. Finally, the transportation of ozone depleting materials

is not contemplated. Accordingly, an Environmental Assessment is not required pursuant to

under 49 C.F.R. § 1105.6(c)(2).

HISTORIC REPORT

SBGR is acquiring operating rights over the involved rail lines for continued rail

operations. Board approval is required for SBGR to discontinue any service, and there are no

plans to dispose of or alter properties subject to Board jurisdiction that are 50 years old or older.

Accordingly, this Notice of Exemption does not require an historic report pursuant to 49 C.F.R. §

1105.8.





Maps







Savage Bingham & Garfield Railroad Company ("SBGR"), a non-carrier, has filed a verified notice of exemption under 49 C.F.R. Part 1150.31 to acquire from the Union Pacific Railroad Company ("UP") and to operate freight easements upon, over and across: (a) the lines of railroad between Milepost 4.66 at Welby and Milepost 17.10 at Magna ("Garfield Branch"), and between Milepost 0.00 at Kearns and Milepost 2.01 at Bacchus ("Bacchus Branch"); (b) various wye, yard and team tracks on UP's Bingham Industrial Lead in the vicinity of Midvale; and (c) the line of railroad between MP 0.18 and MP 6.60 on UP's Bingham Industrial Lead all in Salt Lake County, Utah.

SBGR certifies that its projected annual revenues as a result of this transaction will not result in the creation of a Class II or Class I rail carrier.

The transaction will be consummated on the later of May 1, 2007 or the effective date of this notice.

If the verified notice contains false or misleading information, the exemption is void *ab initio*. Petitions to revoke the exemption under 49 U.S.C. 10502(d) may be filed at any time. The filing of a petition to revoke will not automatically stay the transaction.
