STEAM EXCURSION

The Rocky Mountain Railroad Club has again contracted with member John Birmingham for use of his steam engine, Ex-Great Western No. 51, to head a special club train which will operate out of the Denver Union Station to Longmont, Colorado over the Colorado & Southern. We are presently negotiating with the Burlington for a return trip via the Lyons Branch from Longmont to Burns Junction. If a favorable arrangement cannot be made, the return will be over the Colorado & Southern via Boulder. A number of photo runbys have been planned at suitable locations along the route. No food will be available on the train so bring your own lunch.

Numbers will be drawn from among the ticket stubs and the winners will be awarded rides in the locomotive cab during various parts of the trip.

This is the club's "Do or Die" attempt with this type of trip. If a sufficient number of passengers turn out to enable us to come close to breaking even, trips of this type will continue to be run. However, if your support is not forthcoming, the club's officers and directors will probably not attempt to run further excursions with this locomotive. It is your decision to make.

The price of a ticket is reasonable — \$6.00 for adults and \$3.00 for children under 12. No charge for the little one's under 6. Come on along—bring the kids and your picnic basket and take an old fashioned Sunday excursion.
