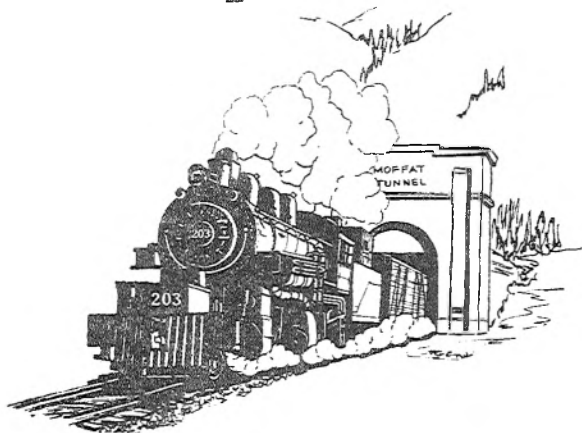

The C&S is greatly upgrading their roadbed between Boulder and Longmont, Colorado with many ties being replaced.

Huron, S.D. is "Alco heaven" on the C&NW. About 20 Alco road switchers are assigned to Huron and about 10 are in the roundhouse at any one time. These units usually work from Pierre, S.D. east to Huron and on to Tracy, Minn. They also work N up to Aberdeen, S.D. and Oakes, N.D.

Amtrack has been on a daily schedule to San Francisco and return since 11 June 1972. Daily service will revert to thrice weekly on or about September 10, 1972.
