

THE BLACK HILLS CENTRAL MOVIES WILL GIVE THOSE OF YOU WHO PLAN TO RIDE THE CLUBS SPECIAL TRAIN FROM HILL CITY TO DEADWOOD AND RETURN NEXT MONTH, SOME IDEA OF THE BEAUTIFUL COUNTRY THIS LINE TRAVERSES.

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BLACK HILLS CENTRAL - DETAILS OF THE CLUBS FALL STEAM TRIP OVER THE SCENIC BURLINGTON NORTHERN LINE BETWEEN HILL CITY AND DEADWOOD, South Dakota are in the enclosed flyer. Anyone who was aboard LAST year will attest to the enjoyment and relaxation this exceptionally well managed special RUN HAS TO OFFER.

THE BLACK HILLS CENTRAL ALSO OPERATES ON A REGULAR SCHEDULE BETWEEN HILL CITY AND GUSTER, AND MAY BE RIDDEN AT THE DISCRETION OF THE VISITOR. REPAIRS TO THE KEYSTONE BRANCH, WHICH CONNECTS WITH THE BN MAINLINE AT HILL CITY, AND SUFFERED HEAVY DAMAGE IN LAST YEARS DISASTEROUS FLOODS, ARE ALMOST COMPLETE. HOWEVER, NO TRIPS ARE EXPECTED OVER IT THIS YEAR.

IT MAY BE NOTED THAT STEAM POWER ISN'T THE ONLY ATTRACTION TO KEEP THE BLACK HILLS VISITOR BUSY. CONCENTRATED IN THE REGION ARE SUCH POINTS OF INTEREST AS CUSTER STATE PARK WITH ITS UNUSUAL ROCK FORMATIONS AND VARIED WILDLIFE, WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK, JEWEL CAVE NAT'L MONUMENT, THE OLD MINING TOWNS OF LEAD AND DEADWOOD, THE RESORT TOWN OF HOT SPRINGS WITH ITS MANY FINE OLD STONE BUILDINGS, RAPID CITY, CHIEF CRAZY HORSE MEMORIAL, AND OF COURSE MT. RUSHMORE, ALWAYS IMPRESSIVE BY DAY OR NIGHT. TO THE EAST IS DEVILS TOWER NAT'L MONUMENT AND TO THE WEST THE BADLANDS NAT'L MONUMENT.

So if you've always wanted to explore the Black Hills region, but never did anything about it, here's a good opportunity to do it both by highway and behind standard gauge steam.

THE AVA IS AN INTERNATIONAL, NON-PROFIT SOCIETY OF COLLECTORS OF TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING TOKENS, WITH MEMBERSHIP OPEN TO COLLECTORS OF ALL AGES. MEMBERS RECEIVE A MONTHLY NEWSLETTER, THE FAREBOX. THIS 12 TO 20 PAGE PUBLICATION COVERS SUCH PERTINENT TOPICS AS TOKEN HISTORIES, RECENT DISCOVERIES OF RARE TOKENS, HINTS ON HOW TO LOCATE OLD AND RARE TOKENS, AND NUMEROUS OTHER ASPECTS OF THE HOBBY. DUES ARE \$5 PER YEAR. The organization holds their annual convention in various cities across the country and Denver has been selected for their 25th. Numercus streetcar, railroad, and transportation related displays will be on exhibit. A token auction will be held, and a color slide program by ED Haley and Dick Kindig will be presented. 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JULY 11TH SAW THE INAUGURAL RUN OF A NEW TRAIN THROUGH DENVER THAT IS CONTRACTED TO RUN FOR AT LEAST 25 years. The Burlington Northern/Colorado and Southern began running a 110 car unit coal TRAIN ON A 1,200 mile round trip every 70 hours between Gillette, Wyo. and the New Public Service Co. of Colorado's New Comanche electric generating power plant Near Pueblo. Two hours are needed to load the 11,000 tons of Low sulphur coal into the train, which moves through the Loading area at 6/10 mph. Upon arrival at the power plant the flat bottom cars, equipped with ROTARY COUPLERS, are inverted for emptying while remaining coupled, a process which takes five Hours. Servicing of the diesel units and the PSC of Colo. owned cars is done at Alliance, Neb.

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- CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW RAIL LINE IS TO BEGIN SOON IN NORTHWESTERN NEW MEXICO. THE NINE MILE LINE W&LEO BE USED TO TRANSPORT COAL FROM A MINE TO THE FOUR CORNERS POWER PLANT. TWENTY-TWO 125 CAPACITY CARS AND THREE DIESEL LOCOMOTIVES WILL REPLACE FIFTEEN TRUCKS CURRENTLY HAULING THE COAL. THE ROAD MAY EVENTUALLY BE EXTENDED ANOTHER SEVEN MILES.
 - "ANOTHER RAILROAD BUILDING PROJECT OF MAJOR PROPORTIONS ABOUNT ONE HUNDRED MILES WEST OF THE Four Corners area is well on the way to completion. The Black Mesa and Lake Powell will begin carrying coal between Kayenta and a new generating plant near Page, Arizona next year. Three electric locomotives will make three round trips a day, six days a week over the 78 mile line, Pulling up to a maximum of eighty 122 ton capacity cars.

PARTICULARLY INTERESTING IS THE FACT THAT THE LINE WILL BE COMPLETELY ELECTRIFIED, WITH A FULLY AUTOMATIC TRAIN CONTROL SYSTEM. THE ENGINEER WILL TAKE OVER THE CONTROLS ONLY IN AM EMER-GENCY OR UNDER UNUSUAL CIRCUMSTANCES. CONTINUOUS WELDED RAIL ON CONCRETE TIES IS USED THROUGH-OUT.

Should you drive over Route 160, the main road to the Grand Canyon from Colorado, the new line can easily be seen, as it parallels the highway for some distance.

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AUTO TRAIN CORPORATIONS DESIRE TO BEGIN SERVICE BETWEEN LOUISVILLE, KY AND FLORIDA HAS BEEN BITTERLY OPPOSED BY AMTRAK. THE AUTO TRAIN WOULD BE COMPETING WITH PRESENT AMTRAK SERVICE. HOWEVER AMTRAK THIS BUT HAS NOT INDICATED IT HAS ANY CONCRETE PLANS FOR RUNNING ITS OWN AUTO CARRYING TRAIN BETWEEN KENTUCKY AND FLORIDA. THE SENATE RECENTLY PASSED A PROVISION WHICH WOULD ABOLISH THE EX-CLUSIVE RIGHT TO AMTRAK TO OPERATE AUTO TRAINS OVER ITS ROUTES.

A RECENT INQUIRY TO AUTO-TRAIN BY A LOCAL COUPLE FOR MOVEMENT OF A CAR AND FOUR PEOPLE, WITH Pullman accompotations, resulted in the surprising information that such accompotations are sold out through January 1974.

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MISCELLANY --- A US ARMY ALCO ROAD SWITCHER WAS OBSERVED WITH REGULAR RIO GRANDE MOTIVE POWER ON AN EASTBOUND FREIGHT IN GLENWOOD CANYON JULY 21ST.

RIO GRANDE'S BUSINESS CAR WAS SEEN TACKED ON BEHIND THE CABOOSE OF A 15 SOME-ODD CAR NORTH-BOUND FREIGHT IN COLORADO SPRINGS THE 12TH OF JULY.
