We start the good-times off with an excursion over the Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad, leaving Chama, N.M. for a round trip to Big Horn and back. Threading our way through beautiful scenery and places with names like Lobato, Windy Point, Cumbres, Los Pinos, Toltec and Cascade, our mixed train will make numerous stops for photo runs. Arrangements have been made for lunch at Osier and we will be able to experience train meets with the regularly scheduled *Colorado Limited* and *New Mexico Express*.

The next day will find us aboard the famous "Silverton Train" of the Durango and Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. Again, we will have a "mixed train" but it will be pulled by double-headed K-28's. We will view the beautiful Hermosa Valley with its brilliant red cliffs, the awesome depths of Animas Canyon, the high steel bridge at Tacoma that spans the rushing waters of the Rio de las Animas Perdidas (River of Lost Souls), and breathe invigorating mountain air scented by the coal smoke of narrow gauge steam power . . . all from the comfort of our Victorian coaches! Many photo run-bys are planned and we will have lunch in Silverton.


