

SPRING FLING TO GLENWOOD ON AMTRAK

April 24 and April 25, 2004

Enjoy the bright green spring colors of the foothills from a California Zephyr window on a trip to Glenwood Springs. Gaze out the picture windows as the train glides past the snow covered peaks and frozen streams of the high Rockies. The Club is offering this two-day adventure to Glenwood Springs and back. This is an opportunity to travel back through time on the old Denver and Salt Lake mainline. Enjoy a cool one in the Sightseer Lounge with your fellow railfans. Have a meal in the diner and talk about old time travel by rail.

After arrival in Glenwood, a van will pick us up and transport us to the Hotel Colorado. The Hotel Colorado is one of the most historic in the state. The hotel was referred to as the "summer White House" during the Presidency of Theodore Roosevelt. There is a dining room and lounge in the hotel if you don't want to walk across the bridge to the many restaurants in downtown Glenwood.

Our package includes a pass to the Hot Springs Pool. We should arrive in time for a full afternoon of fun at the Hot Springs Pool. If you are not into swimming laps, soak in the 104° pool letting the warm spring sun and hot water carry your troubles away.

Before we travel back to Denver on Sunday, we are arranging for the Western Colorado Chapter of the NRHS to present an educational and historical presentation. They remodeled the south end of the depot as a clubroom and museum. The presentation will be at the Glenwood Railroad Museum that is part of the depot.

We will then board our train for the return to Denver through 42 tunnels and 8 canyons. As the afternoon hours drift away, share your time in Glenwood Springs with your fellow travelers and enjoy dinner before detraining at Denver Union Station.

The trip instructions will be mailed on the weekend of April 17, 2004. The instructions will direct you where we will meet at Union Station on Saturday, April 24. Your Trip Leader for this adventure is Michael Tinetti.
