LIKE TO RIDE A TRAIN ?

On Saturday, November 2nd, 1974, the thrilling days of steam will return to the mainline of the Union Pacific Railroad. The last operating steam engine, No. 8444, will once again ascend Sherman Hill for an all day steam excursion.

Our special train will leave Denver Union Station at 7:30 A.M. and will travel the mainline to Greeley with arrival there at 8:30 A.M. After a stop for water, we will continue on to Wyoming & famed Sherman Hill, where several photo stops have been planned. Arrival in Laramie is scheduled for 12:30 P.M., when the train will be turned and the engine serviced. A one hour stop will allow passengers to view the locomotive and other Union Pacific activities. For the return trip, more photo stops have been planned and, after a quick stop at Greeley at 5 P.M., we will speed into Denver with arrival planned for 6:30 P.M.

Fares are as follows: adult round trip from Denver to Laramie is \$27.00; child's ticket is \$22.00(ages 5-12); under 5 ride free. Greeley fares are listed below in the order blank. For other fares and information, please write to the ticket offices listed below. The train will consist of ten reclining seat chair cars(all space reserved in advance), a dome lounge car(seats not reserved-open to all) and a baggage car with tape recorder outlets. Food service will be provided by Henry Daniels Catering Service and is not included in the fare. You are welcome to bring a picnic lunch if you prefer.

For out-of-town visitors, the Passenger Department has a list of accomodations which will be sent with your order on request. While you are in Denver, do not forget to visit the Colorado Railroad Museum in Golden, where you may see an extensive collection of Colorado railroadians- from streetcars to steam locomotives.

We thank you for your interest and hope that you will be aboard on November 2nd for a great trip with Union Pacific 8444.
