



Royal Gorge Train Trip, April 12, 11:00 AM.

This is a historic and educational opportunity to visit the world famous Royal Gorge by train. The Royal Gorge was first viewed by Lt. Zebulon Pike in 1806 and Lt. John Fremont in 1844 on missions of exploration. This was the site of the Royal Gorge War between forces from the D&RG and the AT&SF from 1878 to 1880 to secure the single track right of way bound for Leadville. Some of the ruins of the stone forts are still visible from the war. Last scheduled passenger train through the Gorge was D&RGW train #1 & #2 "The Royal Gorge", on July 27, 1967.

Trip Features:

- Meet at Santa Fe depot south on 3rd St. off US 50 at 11:00 AM. **FURNISH YOUR OWN RIDE**
- Drawing for 4 cab rides at 11:15AM (2 pull rides to Parkdale and 2 push rides to Canon City.)
- Load onto train at 11:30 AM. Depart at 12:00 PM.
- Four choices for box lunches on train.
- Photo run-by at site of Gorge siding
- Open observation and Café car with food, pop, and alcoholic beverages available.
- Shop Tour after train ride
